Submissions can be made from any medium, including but not limited to: watercolor, acrylic paints, pastel, pencil, ink, charcoal, photography, photoshop, or other mixed mediums.

Please consider keeping submissions smaller than 11 x 17 inches. All projects regardless of size will be accepted, but these measurements will be easier to photograph, post on social media, and store in our office without getting damaged. If you have questions or concerns about the size of your art piece, please contact Hannah Barton.

All submissions must include the student's name, school name, teacher name, and phone number. If this information is not included with the submission, we will be unable to send a congratulatory certificate to the student. This information can be pasted on the back of the art piece or on a separate document with submission. Please note that all pieces will be photographed and posted on social media, so do not include sensitive information on the front of your art piece. If you do *not* want your piece to be posted on social media, please include that request with your submission. The full names of students will NOT be posted on social media.

Congressional Certificates will be mailed directly to the student's school after May 13, 2019. All submissions can be picked up in our District Office after May 13, 2019. **Submissions should be picked up no later than June 14, 2019.** All pieces that are not picked up will be used to decorate our District Office in West Jordan, UT.
